2026 SCHOLARSHIP/STIPEND APPLICATION

Mr. John J. Wright was the founder of the John J. Wright School in Snell, Virginia. Education was his greatest love. The scholarship fund, established in 1994, is intended to continue his efforts on behalf of (1) descendents of John J. Wright Alumni, and (2) descendents of associate or honorary members of the John J. Wright Alumni Association

The John J. Wright Memorial Scholarship/Stipend Program is accepting applications from:

1. **High school student applicants** who will graduate spring 2026 and who are planning to attend a technical school, community college, or a four-year college or university in fall 2026 on a full-time basis. **(may be eligible for a Scholarship)**
2. **First time applicants** who have graduated from high school and who are planning to attend a technical school, community college, or a four-year college or university in fall 2026 as a full-time student. **(may be eligible for a Stipend)**
3. **Returning student applicants** who are planning to return to a technical school, community college, or a four-year college or university in fall 2026 as a full-time student. **(may be eligible for a Stipend)**

The complete application package must be submitted to the scholarship committee no later than **March 31, 2026**, and contain the following:

1) **High school applicant** package checklist:

- ☐ a completed scholarship application form
- ☐ an official, sealed, high school transcript that includes the cumulative GPA
- ☐ a brief bio in paragraph form
- ☐ two (2) recommendations (one from a teacher and one from an official of one of the following: current school, community organization, church, or employer)
- ☐ a written essay
- ☐ small photo

2) **First time applicant** package checklist:

- ☐ a completed scholarship application form
- ☐ an official, sealed, high school or college transcript that includes the cumulative GPA
- ☐ a brief bio in paragraph form
- ☐ two (2) recommendations (from an official of one or more of the following: current school, community organization, church, or employer)
- ☐ a written essay
- ☐ small photo

3) **Returning student applicant** package checklist:

- ☐ a completed scholarship application form
- ☐ a brief bio in paragraph form
- ☐ a one-page essay on community service conducted within the last 12 months
- ☐ an official sealed college transcript that includes the cumulative GPA

Applicants will be sent notification of the status of their application via email by April 30, 2026

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ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- **All applicants** must be an “active financial member” of the John J. Wright Alumni Association, **OR** the offspring of an “active financial member” of the Alumni Association (offspring may be a child, foster child, adopted child, grandchild, great grandchild)
- **The member**, upon whom the applicant is basing their eligibility, must be an “active financial member of the current year, 2026, **AND** a member for the prior year 2025). Membership dues must be paid by March 15 of the current year.
- **All applicants** must have graduated or be graduating from an accredited secondary educational institution.
- **High School applicants** and **first-time applicants** must have applied for admission to at least one accredited technical school, community college, or four-year college or university.
- **High School applicants and first-time applicants** must have a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or higher.
- **All high school and first-time applicants** must provide two (2) recommendations from an official of one or more of the following: current school, community organization, church, or employer. One (1) of the two recommendations must be from a high school teacher if applicant is in high school.
- **All high school and first-time applicants** are required to submit a small high school picture and a brief bio narrative. The bio can be included on the application form.
- **Returning student applicants** must be full-time students returning to a technical school, community college, or four-year college or university **AND** have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- A personal interview, consisting of an oral presentation of the applicant’s essay and a question/response period, **may** be required.
- **ALL applicants** must provide a sealed official transcript to the Scholarship Committee with the applicant package.
- **ALL applicants** must provide proof they are enrolled in school for the fall semester before receipt of scholarship/stipend.
- **ALL applicants** must agree to return any scholarship/stipend award if applicant does not attend an educational institution or technical school in fall 2026.
- **Applicants can receive a scholarship and/or stipend no more than four (4) times.**

APPLICATION ESSAY

All graduating high school applicants and first-time applicants must submit a double spaced, typewritten essay, 300 to 500 words in length, on one of the following topics:

- 1) “My chosen field of study is ...because...”
- 2) “My community, church or family has influenced me by...”
- 3) “It is important for me to attend college or technical training because

All returning students must submit a double spaced, typewritten essay, one page in length, on the following topic. **“It is important for me to do community service so I (did what?) over the last year in my community, church, school, etc, to”**

Failure to address one of the specified topics disqualifies the essay and the application from consideration for a scholarship/stipend award.
